Ideas of what to include:


- Write down popular songs & tv shows

Paper Elf Craft

Materials:

- Red and green cardstock
- Red and green glitter paper
- Small red buttons
- Small white pom poms
- Photo of face

Toilet Paper Grinch

Materials:

- Collect toilet paper rolls
- -Paint, pompoms, coloured paper, glue
- -Any decorative items you want

SPOT THE DIFFERENCE!

Get your eyes ready because this is tricky. Grab a timer (or move at a leisurely pace) and see how many differences you can find between the two pictures in one minute. You can have this on your computer and **use the "share your screen feature" while video chatting** with your mentee so that you can both look at this together!

1. Christmas Tree Image:

The image below has 6 different Christmas trees. One of them isn't like the others. Can you figure out which one?

Hint: Make sure you look closely at the decorations and the different snow patterns on the trees.




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1. **Answer- Christmas Tree Image**: The Christmas tree that isn't like the other is number two. If you look closely, you'll notice that on all the other trees, the left and right sides are decorated with identically colored Christmas tree lights. The two lights on the bottom branches of Christmas tree number two are two different colors.

2. Donut Differences:

The image on the left is the original picture and the one on the right has been tweaked a little. See if you can find all 8 differences!
